Via I-95 Northbound: Exit 27(Lafayette Blvd. Downtown) - Keep to the right through three traffic lights. Turn left at the 4th light (Broad Street), going under I-95. Library is at the end of the block on the corner of Broad and State Streets.

Via I-95 Southbound: Exit 27, turn right onto Lafayette Blvd. At 3rd traffic light, turn right onto State Street. At light, turn right onto Broad Street. Library is on the corner of State and Broad Streets.

Via Merritt Parkway: Exit 47 (Park Ave.) South to State Street. Take a left onto State Street at the YMCA. Three traffic lights to Broad Street. Take a right. Library is on the corner of State and Broad Streets.

Via Route 8/25 Southbound: Exit 2 (Fairfield Ave.) Straight until you can go no further. This is State Street. Take a left onto State Street. Two traffic lights to Broad Street and take a right. Library is on the corner of State and Broad Streets.

Parking is available on Saturday in the parking lot that is accessed on Cesar Batalla Street between Main and State Street...behind Ralph and Rich's restaurant. Please do not park in the spaces designated for the restaurant...but there are plenty more spaces. And, on Saturday you can park on Broad Street without worrying about putting money in the meters! (or after 6:30 weekdays).
