In Memoriam

MICHAEL JOSEPH GANNON

Nov. 28, 1939 — December 6, 1955

Time: December, 1975. Place: Bustling city of Swisherville, named after James Swisher, who made his millions by investing in Harold Walsh's vitamin extract for emaciated football players.

On a dreary winter morning, Bob Venman, department store tycoon and famous sportsman, is suddenly awakened from his dream of his forth-coming vacation in sunny Hawaii by his butler and body guard, Charles Kenny, who reminds him that he will have to hurry if he wishes to attend the stockholders' meeting before sailing time. After taking his Veit Vitamins, he picks up the phone and calls room service. Doorman Roger Campolucci opens the door to the Venman Limousine driven by Richard Lichtenwald.

Driving down Byam's Boulevard, named after Leonard Byam, the famous comedian now starring nightly at the Bear Mountain Inn, they are passed by Piazza's Popsicle tricycle. Owner Mike Piazza is peddling furiously in an attempt to reach Grant's Grammar School for morning recess. This school was named after the world-famous educational pioneer, Kathleen Grant. Suddenly the car comes to a dead stop to avoid hitting Florence Farber's prize Pekingese, Sol, who won first place at the Cassano Kennel Club.

Bob enters Conference Room 15, where he is greeted by the Board of Directors headed by William Shultz. Seated at the right of the table is Grace Ober, the only woman stockholder, who is still talking from last month's meeting. After the treasurer Bob (Scrooge) Durwin gives his report, the meeting is adjourned because R.V. decides to tour the store before leaving.

He goes into an executive suite, an enormous room designated for television monitors, one for each floor of the store. This room was designed by Dick Freeman, technical genius. Bob sits in his new Rescsanski reclining chair and turns his eyes to the viewers.

As he checks the first floor of his store, he notices a crowd of people gathered around Jeri Reid, who is demonstrating Kofoed's Kollapsable Kosmetic Kases to Betty Fray, Loretta Kish, and Barbara Jasmin. In the background Robert Firment, Bob Sword, and Tony Feil, who are the only ones tall enough, are washing the ceiling-to-floor windows with Siegel's Soap Suds for Painless Window Cleaning.

From there the camera moves to the women's shoe department where Kathy Buckley is being fitted for a pair of Aylott's Alpine Snow Repellent Mountain Climber's Boots by Roger Woznick. Turning, the camera spots Howland Foster in working overalls, scraping chewing gum from the backs of chairs with the aid of hitrusty slide rule.

On the second floor store detective Barbara Chasse is chasing a small chimpanzee which has escaped from the Pet Department. Running down the narrow aisles lined with Bonvicini's Cut Crystal Candy Dishes, he bumps into floorwalker Myron Warshaw, who trips and falls into a three-gallon punch bowl filled with Hubiska's Health Tonic. To add to the confusion, salesgirl Joan Flynn, demonstrating a new line of New Year's noise-makers and baby rattles, is having trouble with four rattlesnakes, also escaped from the pet department. Bob, loving our little woodland friends, makes a mental note to remove the manager of this department.

Unable to stand the noise, Bob switches to the third floor sports department, where Marty Solomon is autographing copies of his new book, How I Climbed to The Top of The Tiddly-Wink Kingdom.
