And love be our eternal guide.

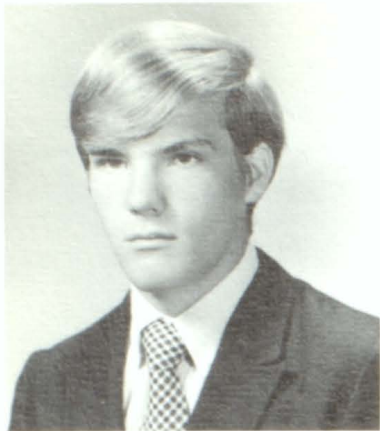

Math Club

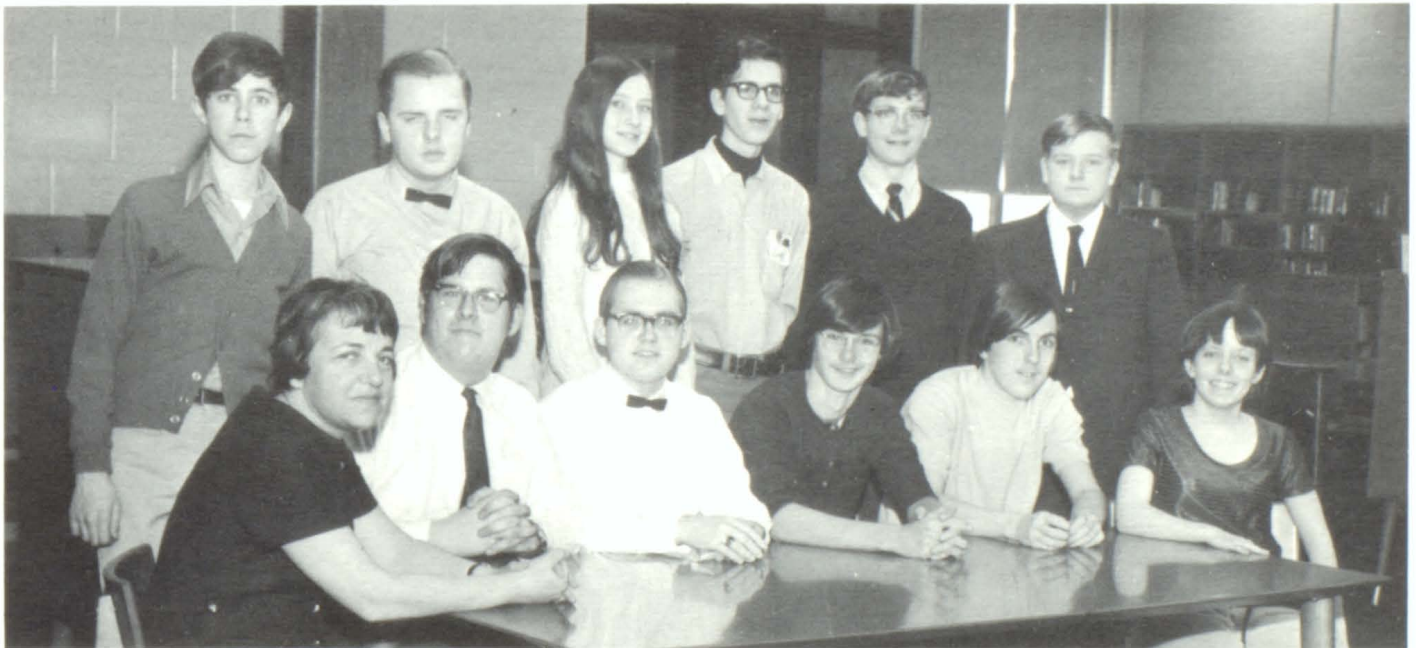

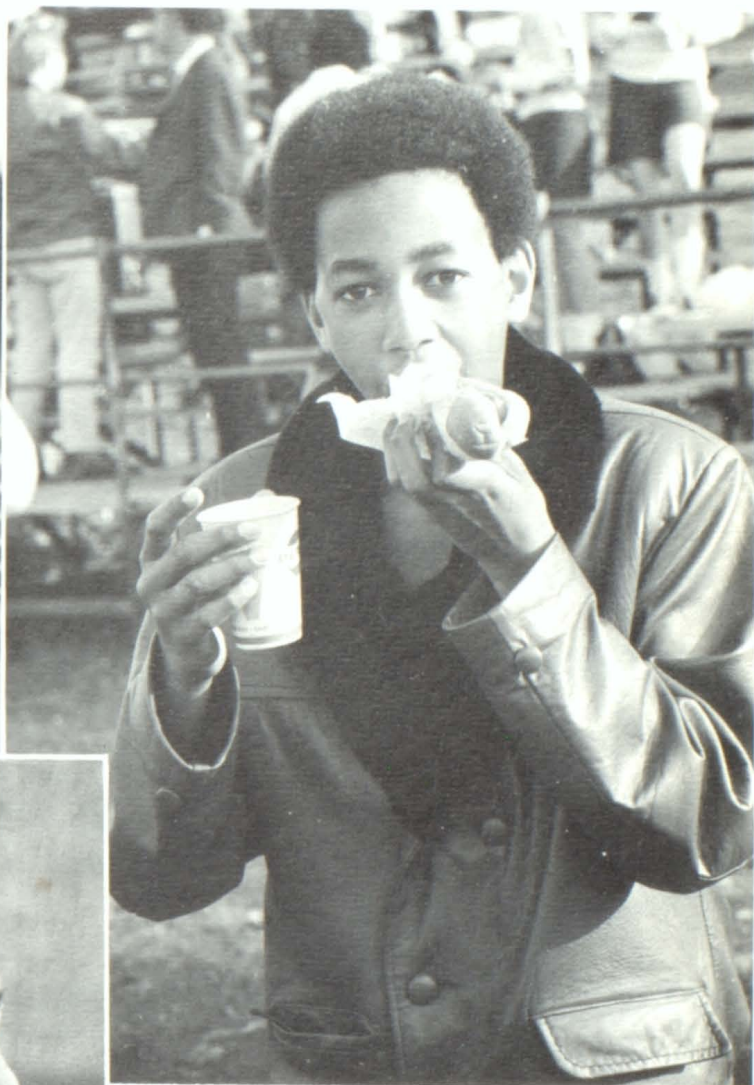
Christmas Assembly
