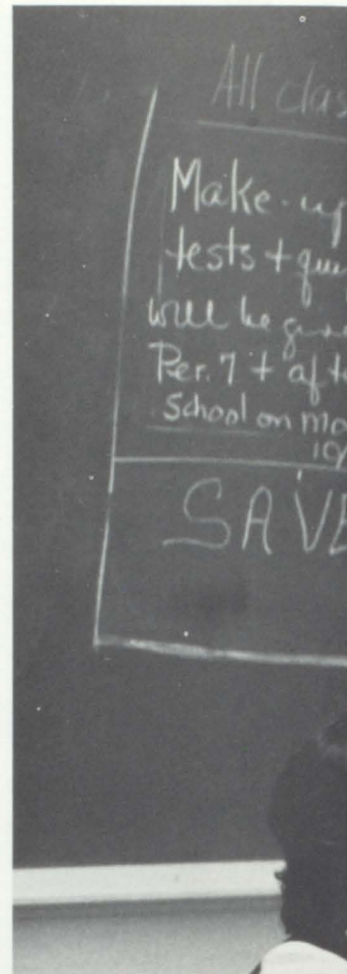
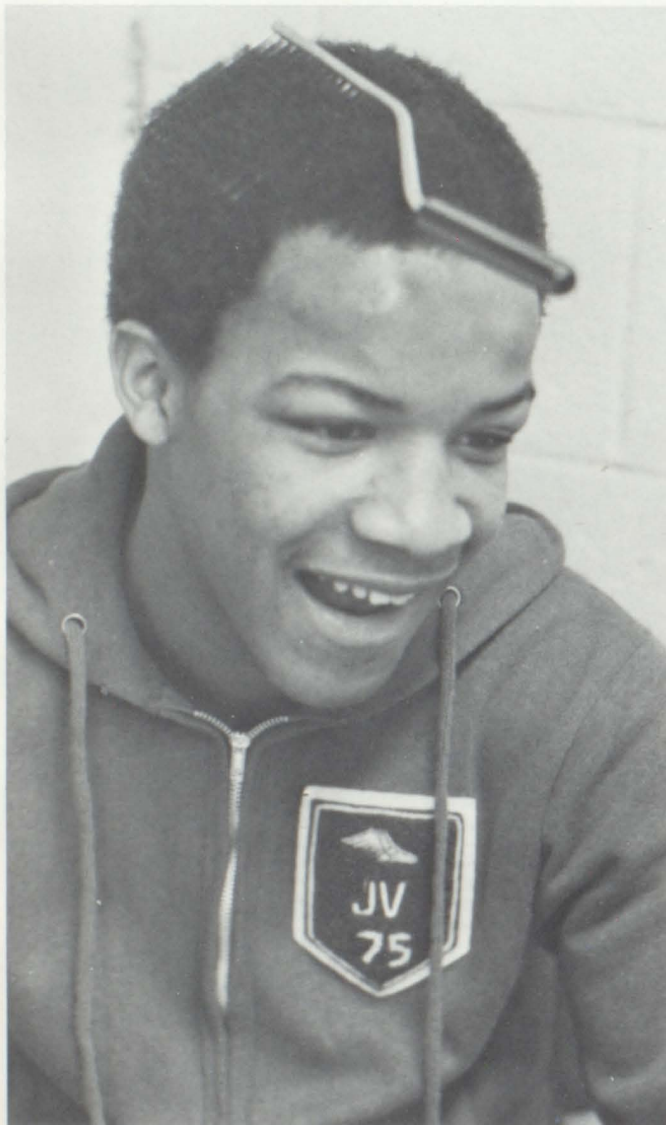






this year we celebrate our country's bicentennial which commemorates the struggle of our founding fathers to create a new government. we refer to their efforts as the spirit of '76.



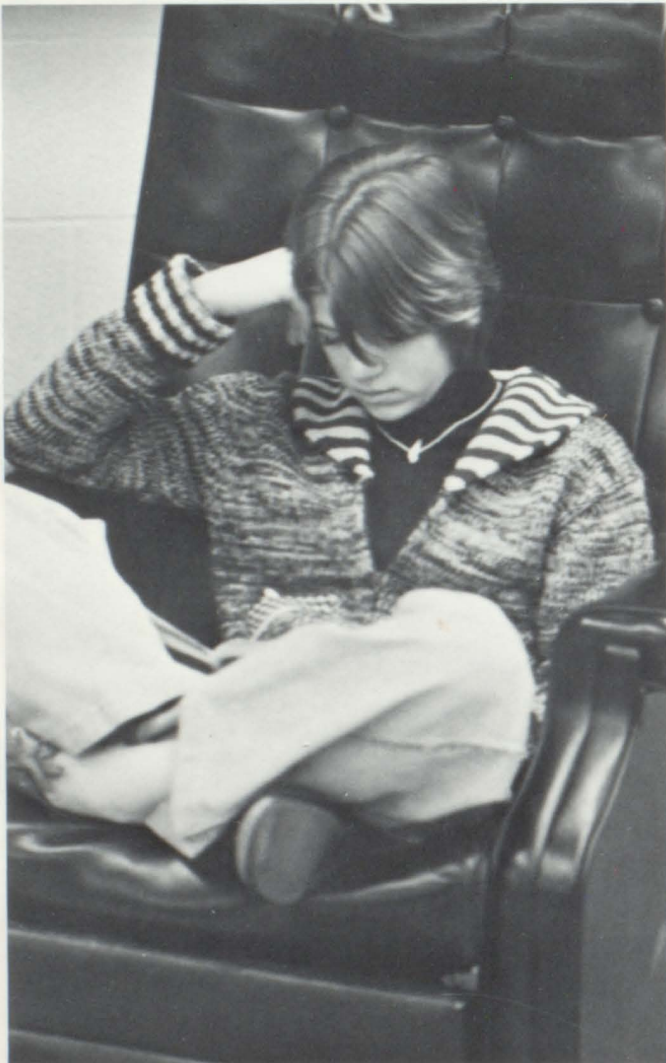

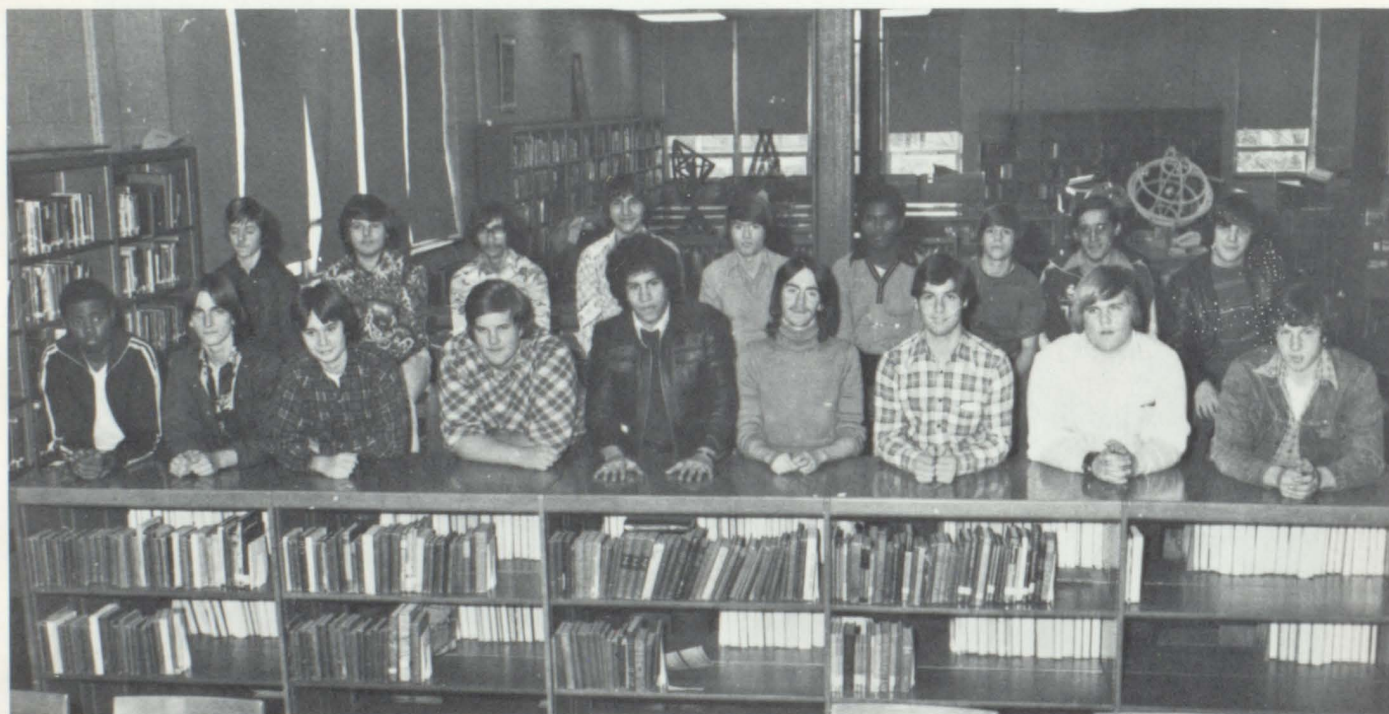


# key club

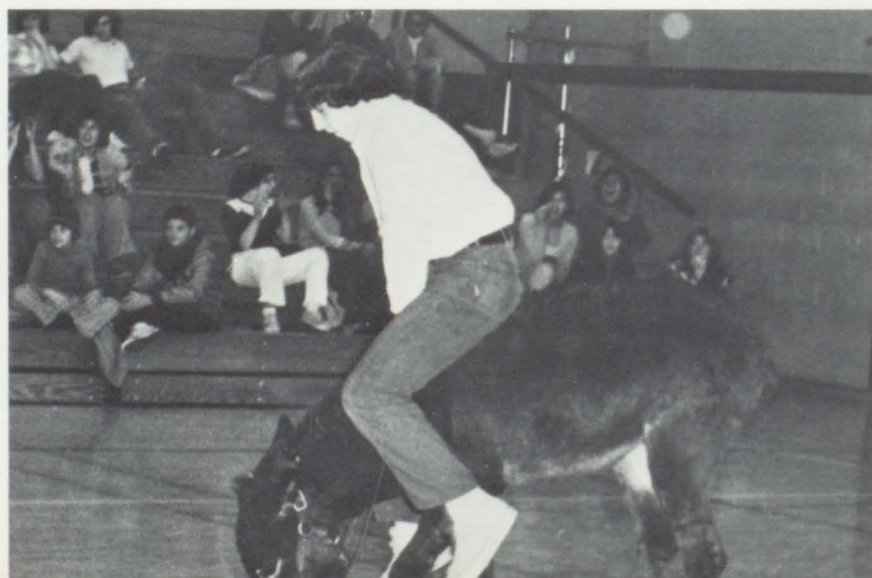




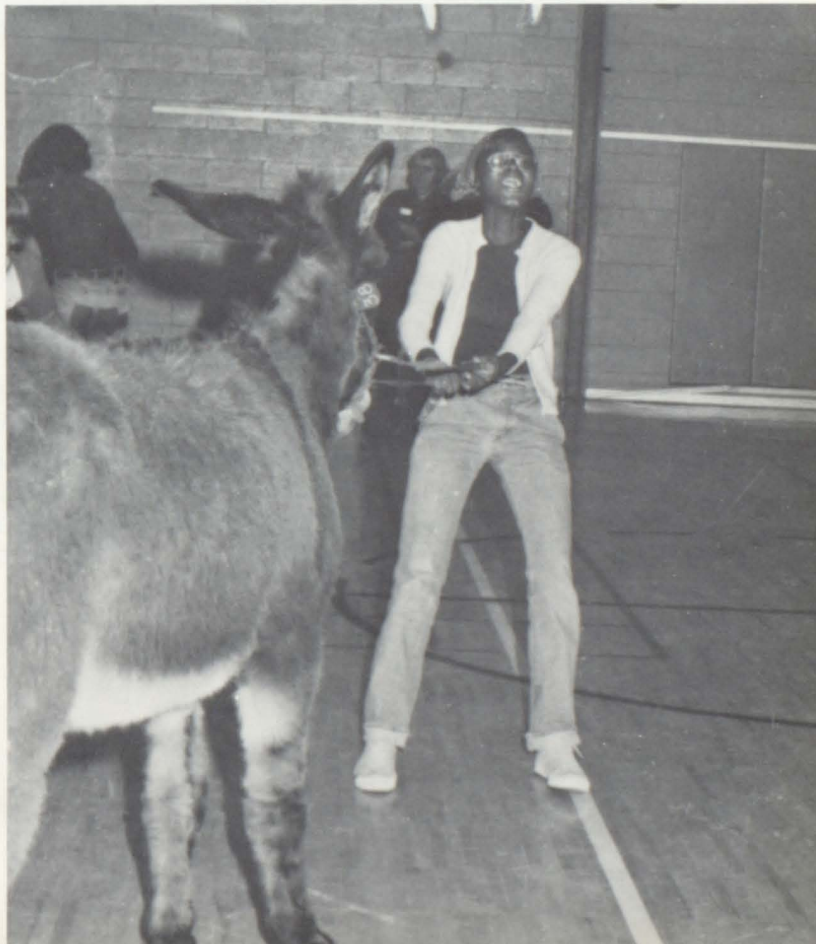
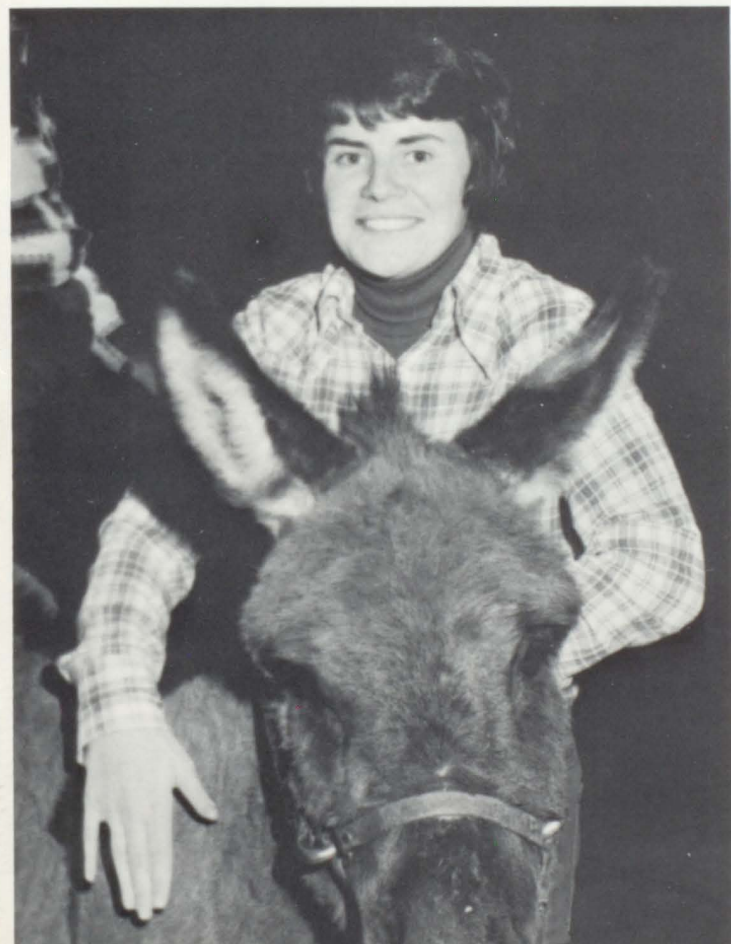
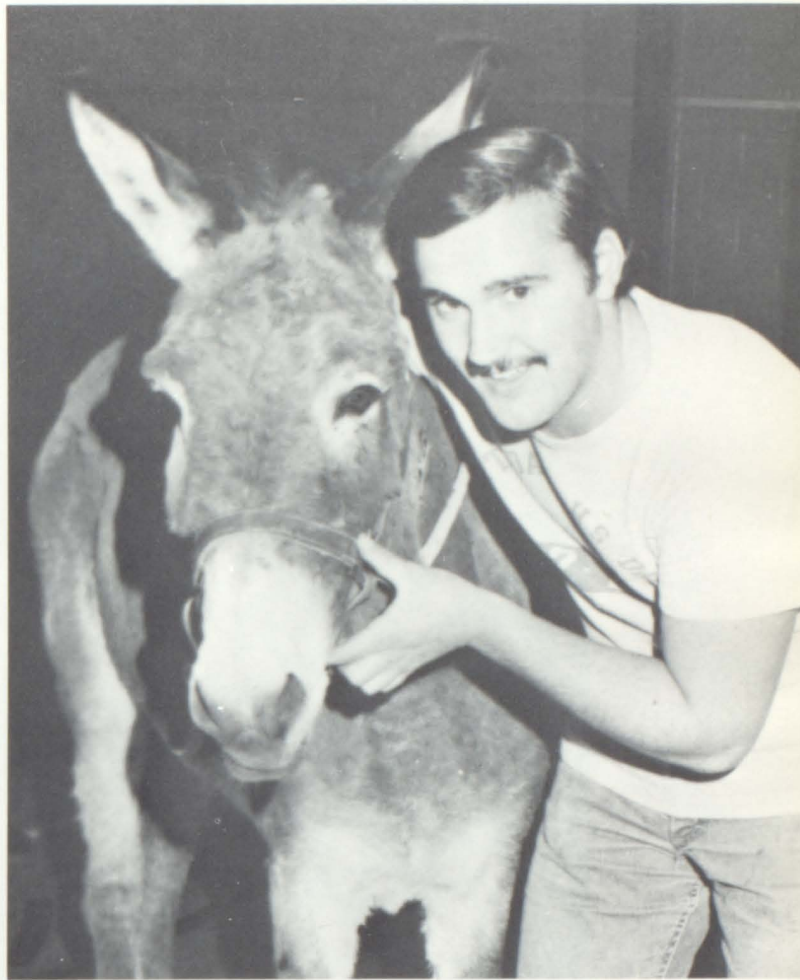
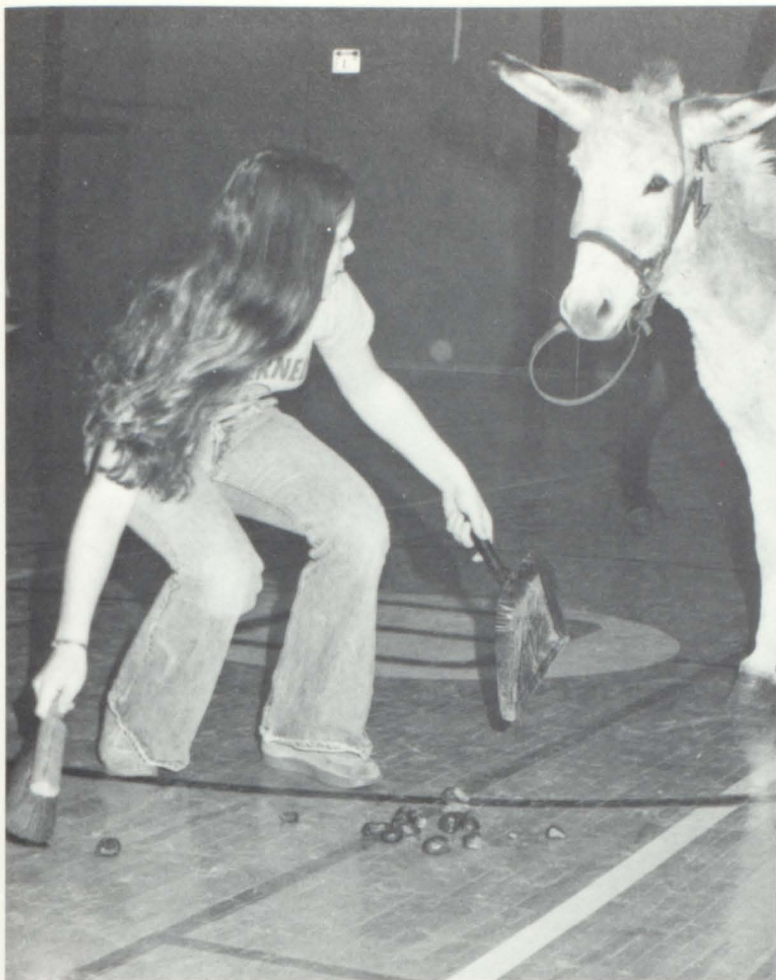


# donkey basketball

In celebrating our country's bicentennial we are really celebrating that spirit that shaped the efforts of our founding fathers.








It is this spirit working within each of us that affects all we do: our work, our thoughts, our ambitions and our relationships with others.
