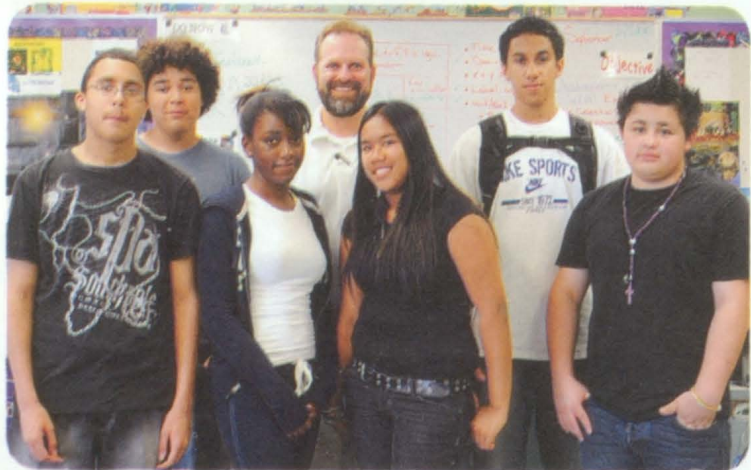


# ADVISORY

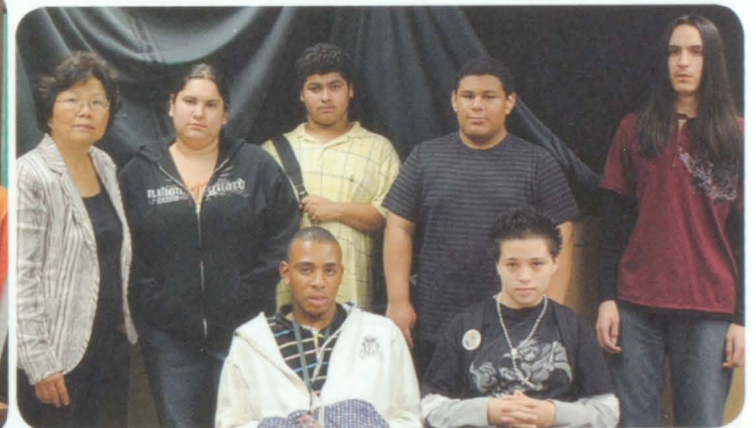
