Abstract: Edward A. Nevins spent most of his career at the Singer Sewing Machine Company in Bridgeport, Connecticut. He worked in the drafting department, eventually holding the title of chief draftsman. Present in this collection are blueprints and technical drawings for various machine

parts, starting in the 1900s and ending in the 1950s.

Biographical History:

Born in 1889, Edward A. Nevins had a keen interest in technical drawing from an early age. He went on to work for Singer Sewing Machines in Bridgeport, Connecticut, eventually receiving the title of chief draftsman for the company. His technical work helped to detail individual pieces of sewing machines in the company, and often times his drawings were published in trade publications, such as those featured in the collection.

In his personal life, Nevins married Malvina (sometimes recorded as Melvina) Gazzolo on June 21, 1920. Edward passed in November 1979.

Additional research is being conducted at this time.

Scope and Content:

The bulk of the material present in the collection are blueprints and technical drawings done for the Singer Sewing Machine company. Also present, albeit in lesser quantity, are published technical drawings that were used in magazines and promotional material both by Singer and companies that produced machine parts.

Arrangement note:

Material has been grouped by technical drawings (series I) and published drawings (series II.) Each group is arranged chronologically. Additional material has been placed in a short series (III) at the end of the collection.
