Biographical History

The national level of the League of Women Voters was founded on February 14, 1920 in Chicago. It was meant to help newly enfranchised female voters carry out the highly fought for civic duty. State and local level offices were created in order to work at those levels of government and encourage education for women, but also men.

On the state level, the Connecticut league was founded in New Haven in 1921. It pushed for jury service for women within the state, and the Connecticut Constitutional Convention among other highlights. The records of the state level league are available at the <u>Connecticut State Library</u>.

The Bridgeport History Center is currently researching the history of the Bridgeport league.

Scope and Content note:

This collection feature alphabetical subject files that reflect both political issues at the time but also the interests of the constituents of the organization at both the local and national level. The minutes are of particular use for local voting interests.
