**Abstract:** he International Alliance of Theatrical Stage Employees and

Moving Picture Machine Operators was founded in 1893 and is an active union to this day. Within Bridgeport, membership was weighted towards movie theatre employees who worked the projection booths in the many, many movie theatres in and around Bridgeport. Founded in [X] and dissolved in 1993, the records of local 277 provide insight into the finances, history,

and Bridgeport members of IATSE.

## Biographical / Historical

ATSE itself was founded in 1893 by stage hands seeking fair wages and safer working conditions. It has grown to encompass live theatre workers, the motion picture industry, television, broadcast, concert halls, animation, and almost every other element of theatre

Currently IATSE has an estimated 140,000 members.

Bridgeport's chapter of IATSE, local 277, was focused primarily on employees in the many movie theatres in and around Bridgeport. Founded in [x], the seniority lists and applications in the collection show a robust union from the 1920s until the 1980s. Much of their local work was focused on negotiating fair contracts with theatre owners for their union members and ensuring pensions and benefits, especially as the early membership aged.

They were primarily represented by Roy Gilbert, whose memory prompted the donation of these materials. He represented the union at the 1993 100th anniversary convention as a delegate, but also helped to see the shuttering of the 277. By the early 1990s, a decline in membership and lack of new blood caused the union to fall below the minimum requirement of 7 members as required by the union itself. As such, Local 277 disbanded and remaining members entered other parts of IATSE in Connecticut.

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# **Scope and Contents**

The records of IATSE Local 277 were donated in memory of union representative Roy Gilbert, who passed in 1995. These records are likely what he himself retained while working in that capacity, and reflect some bias in what is present. There are copies of the national by-laws and constitutions, but much of the material relates to pension and benefits, union membership lists, and the various contracts negotiated with theatre owners over the years to ensure that union members were fairly and justly represented. In addition, the financial documents run from the mid-1970s to 1993, when Local 277 disbanded. As Local 277 was heavily focused on motion picture theatres rather than live theatre, there are a number of manuals and instruction booklets related to projectionists and their material. They include sound, lighting, platters, projection machines themselves, and several instances of 3-d picture instructions. This includes a 1954 special instruction booklet solely for the motion picture "Phantom of the Rue Moruge" - instructions that include marketing elements as well as information for the projectionist. It was a part of Warner Brother's initial push of 3d into the marketplace.

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## Arrangement

Series I, IATSE National, contains material related to IATSE in it's national level capacity. This primarily involves the by-laws and constitutions put out every year, but also pension information and history of the union itself.

Series II, Local 277, contains history, information about the dissolution, and minutes. Also included are select membership cards, applications, and seniority lists that offer insight into individual members but also document the decline. Also included are the various exams that Connecticut required to be a projectionist during the 1980s.

Series III consists of contracts with various theatres in and around Bridgeport including the Klein Memorial Auditorium.

Series IV consists of various financial documents - especially from the 1980s onward. The combination of ledgers, financial reports, and bank statements, documents the decline in membership.

The next series, series V, contains manuals for various motion picture theatre equipment like lighting and power, platters, and projectors. Of note is the information about the special 3-d kit for "Phantom of the Rue Morgue" released in 1954. It is part advertising copy and part instructions for the projectionist, and an incredibly interesting look into the start of the 3-D motion picture fad that comes in waves.

Series VI represents Roy Gilber's briefcase. The material within all related to the 1993 convention that celebrated IATSE's 100th anniversary, and much of it relates to that event. The briefcase and it's contents have been kept in an original order.

Finally, series VII represents true miscellaneous martial like time sheets, a blueprint for a concession stand, IATSE buttons, and 3-d glasses.
