Abstract: Park Street Congregational Church was founded on January 15, 1868 under the original name of the East Bridgeport Congregational Church. This collection balances the financial and administrative elements of the church with lay religious life, offering insight into the East End of

Bridgeport in the late 19th and early 20th centuries.

Administrative History:

Park Street Congregational Church was founded on January 15, 1868 under the original name of the East Bridgeport Congregational Church. Their first pastor was Rev. John Davenport, and services were first held at the Bethesda Mission Chapel. The congregation would later move to a custom built building by Abram Skaats located on Park Street and Barnum Avenue, giving the church it's new name.

The church was organized with a pastor and with a corporate auxiliary body run by lay members that managed business and financial obligations. This body was essential to management, just as the Women's League and Fullerton Memorial Circle were to outreach and charity work that demonstrated their faith. Park Street Congregational Church boasted a well-attended Sunday school as well.

However, as the years went on, membership declined. This is noted in the 1968 booklet celebrating the church's 100th anniversary. Park Street Congregational Church would go on to merge with Trinity United Church of Christ in Trumbull. The two organizations are now the Unity Hill United Church of Christ, and the Park Street building is home to Calvary Temple Christian Center.

Note that The Story of a Church by John S. Wooster in the collection provides a detailed history of the church from 1868 to 1937 with a focus on all pastors and the key events in the church's history up until that time.

Scope and Content note:

This collection balances the financial and administrative elements of the church with religious life. There are extensive reports, financial documents, and administrative material from most of the church's history, mostly focused on day-to-day management. The presence of various church newsletters from most of the congregation's 20th Century history helps to not only compliment

administrative matters but inform lay religious life as well. This is especially true for material in the Women's League sub-series, and helps emphasize the role of women in lay life.

Not extensively documented are materials specifically related to the Sunday school. In addition, there is a group of unprocessed material related to Gabriel Rider and the Rider family, whose significance at the Park Street Congregational Church is still under review.

Arrangement Note:

Series I, organizational rules and reports contains manuals, by-laws, and reports such as annual reports and church council meetings. These reports run from about the 1940s to late 1970s. The second series, church groups, primarily contains documentation of the Women's League, but also includes the Fullerton Memorial Circle, Friendly Service Committee, and Young People's Alliance.

Series III, membership, primarily consists of directories. However, it is worth noting that there is one folder of baptism records included, although these records are not complete or inclusive.

Series IV contains church newsletters starting in 1876 and running up until the time of donation, whereas series V contains what the church called calendars, but are in fact worship schedules and other church information.

These series are followed by series VI, anniversaries, containing anniversary material. Subject files are next in series VII, and are divided into sub-series 1 - general and sub-series 2 alphabetical files. The general subject files are chronological only, and mostly contain material from 1970-1980. The topical files are alphabetical and generally earlier, and include early records and writings of the church's first pastor.

Series IX, relationships with other churches, consists of material related to Bridgeport's interfaith community and other Congregational churches in Connecticut. Series X, Gabriel Rider material, contains unprocessed material related to a member of the church community. It will be examined at a later time.

The final series, XI, contains photographs of the church and church activities.
