Abstract: The Young Women's Christian Association of Greater Bridgeport- now the Center for Family Justice - was founded in 1895. During this era, Bridgeport was a factory city with an extensive industrial arm. As such, female factory workers both born in the United States and recently immigrated were drawn to Bridgeport for work. The YWCA provided a support network, as well as leisure, entertainment, and guidance. Although the organization has gone through a number of changes over the years, its goal of supporting women and giving them the resources they need most has not changed. The records in this collection document the transformation from 1895 through the massive restructuring in the 1970s, and ends at 1990, providing insight and careful documentation of how the Center for Family Justice rose from the original 1895 YWCA.

Administrative History:

The Young Women's Christian Association of Greater Bridgeport- now the Center for Family Justice - was founded in 1895. During this era, Bridgeport was a factory city with an extensive industrial arm. As such, female factory workers both born in the United States and recently immigrated were drawn to Bridgeport for work. The YWCA provided a support network, as well as housing accommodations for certain individuals in need.

The original building at 343 Main Street was used until 1918 when the organization moved to 263 Golden Hill Street instead, where it remained until 1981.

In 1921, the Phyllis Wheatley branch opened. Pointedly for women of color, the organization remained segregated until 1942. The Phyllis Wheatley branch is fondly remembered in a number of oral histories from Black women, located in the Bridgeport History Center's Afro-American Educators Oral History Project collection.

As a herald of things to come, the organization's name was officially changed to the Young Women's Christian Association of Greater Bridgeport in 1966, allowing it to include neighboring communities. It was at this time that a massive restructuring began, and the organization began to refine its mission in the wake of the Civil Rights movement. A firm focus on social justice and institutional inequality motivated the creation of the Everywoman's Center, the Center for Creative Leisure, and the Center for Racial Justice. The work of restructuring is closely reflected in the files

of the executive directors in the collection, along with the series related to the Everywoman's Center.

The YWCA's services began to include a greater focus on meeting the needs of women dealing with domestic violence, poverty, and houselessness. By 1995, the YWCA's focus on serving domestic and sexual violence cases caused a disaffiliation from the YWCA parent organization. The Center for Women and Families of Eastern Fairfield County retained that name until 2014, when the former YWCA of Bridgeport became the Center for Family Justice, the first of its kind in the state.

The center remains at 753 Fairfield Avenue, offering services and support for women of Fairfield County.

Scope and Content note:

The Records of the YWCA of Greater Bridgeport provide insight into the organization's history from 1895 to 1995, when the last group of records were donated to the Bridgeport History Center.

Minutes come from the organization's entire history up into 1990, providing remarkable continuity into the organization as it evolved from its original purpose to assist female factory workers in Bridgeport to the organization's current form to provide support for women in a non-sectarian setting.

However, the bulk of the material comes from the Executive Director files, mostly from Clarice Owns and Beverly Rashid. Their stewardship of the organization oversaw the massive restructuring of the YWCA, and the first step towards its larger mission and focus on women's issues. Included within is extensive work with the Center for Creative Leisure, the Center for Racial Justice, and the Everywoman's Center, all built on a foundation of strengthening civil rights, combating racism, and securing greater equality for women of Bridgeport and eastern Fairfield County.

Curiously absent as a series is material relating to the Phyllis Wheatley branch. There is some discussion in the files about integrating the branch into the parent building on Golden Hill Street, as well as some scrapbooks, but a separate set of files did not come to the Bridgeport History Center.

The photograph series, while small, contains images of the early days of the YWCA, including building interiors and activities.

Arrangement Note:

The first series contains minutes of executive committees. Subseries 1 represents general minutes and the original organization structure of the YWCA, which originally was split between a Board of Managers and an Executive Committee. They streamlined to a single committee in 1930, only to branch out again. Subseries 2 and 3, the Board of Trustees and the Board of Directors, reflect this branching out again. The material was also a part of accession 1994.35 and is housed in boxes 29-31 to reflect this. All material is in original chronological order. Subseries 4 represents other committee minutes, most at the executive level. Earlier material is retained in original filing order in the boxes, especially material from 1916-1920.

Series II contains material from the Office of the Executive Director, divided into subseries. The first subseries reflects combined earlier director files which were filed only by subject and not by director. Subseries 2 represents the material for Carolyn Owens.

Subseries 3 represents the material of Beverly Rashid and subseries 4 represents the material of Robin Owens. Subseries 5 represents a box that was labeled "combined office files Owens and Rashid." These may have been shared office files within the building itself. They have been left as a subseries for this reason. Likewise it is unclear which Owens – Carolyn or Robin – is referred to here.

Subseries 3 represents the publicity office's work under Mary Witsil from the late 1960s into the 1970s. It is in original order.

General office files make up series IV, and are divided into subseries based on original box labels. Two boxes were labeled as being from the 1930s-1960s and had alphabetical dividers – they make up subseries I. Subseries 2 represents other office files that were packed away. It was suggested on the box that they may have been from Lazaruk and Causbie (see series VII), but it is impossible to confirm.

Series VI, Buildings, is divided into three subseries. The first relates to the YWCA's Golden Hill property, whereas the second relates to the Everywoman Center with an emphasis on architectural bids. Subseries 3, building manager files, represents the files kept by custodial and building staff. All material is arranged alphabetically.

Series VII represents the director files of the Everywoman Center, the first major change in the Y.W.C.A.'s identity to what it is now. Subseries I features the material of Lillie Margaret Lazaruk whereas subseries 2 contains material belonging to Ittan Causibe. Subject files arranged alphabetically.

Series VIII represents various statistics from over the life of the organization, and series IX features activities and programs the organization provided. Photographs, flyers, and clubs are represented here. Arranged alphabetically.

Series X, the scrapbooks, contains extensive documentation of Y.W.C.A. activities as reported in local newspapers. They complement what is present elsewhere in the collection, and is also the only section to feature material specifically related to the Phyllis Wheatley branch. From 1921 to 1942 the organization was segregated and this branch served Bridgeport's Black population. Material is in chronological order, with the material related to the Phyllis Wheatley branch placed first.

Series XI represents additional material whose original box label was "other." It represents material that the organization suspected it ought to retain, but wasn't sure how to file. It is in original order.
