Abstract: The Urban Coalition of Greater Bridgeport Inc. was founded in 1968. Its formation was in response to the ongoing racial turmoil in the United States at the time, and modeled on and in partnership with the National Urban Coalition. The coalition's goal was to provide communication and interaction between residents, the region, business, and government, all while acting independently. To meet Bridgeport's specific needs, there was a strong focus on education,

housing, and police-community relations.

Biographical History:

The Urban Coalition of Greater Bridgeport Inc. was founded in 1968. Its formation was in response to the ongoing racial turmoil in the United States at the time, and modeled on and in partnership with the National Urban Coalition. The National Urban Coalition was formed in 1967, as white flight, civil unrest in response to the civil rights movement, and the need for residential support and improvement combined and were coming into focus.

Bridgeport's Urban Coalition was housed in McLevy Hall, and most active from 1970 until 1976, when it seems to have disbanded. The coalition's goal was to provide communication and interaction between residents, the region, business, and government, all while acting independently. To meet Bridgeport's specific needs, there was a strong focus on education, housing, and police-community relations. These topics are strongly reflected in the subject file series of the collection, which shows the planning, research, and correspondence conducted in order to meet organizational goals.

Some of the Urban Coalitions' tangible results included partnering with Action for Bridgeport Community Development (ABCD) on Project YES, publishing minority business directories, research and solutions for education reform in the city, and creating a report on revenue sharing in Fairfield County to address inequality.

The coalition's board of directors included activists Cesar Batalla, Rev. Roger Floyd whose papers are held by the Bridgeport History Center, and Beverly Rashid who served as an executive director at the Bridgeport YWCA during the time the YWCA's mission was shifting towards social justice. Anne S. Finnie served as director for most of the organization's lifespan, and the Urban Coalition received wide support from Bridgeport businesses.

Scope and Content note:

The bulk of the collection is made up of subject files which were removed from the Coalition's offices in McLevy Hall. These subject files show the nuts and bolts of the Coalition's various projects, and focus heavily on education, police-community relations, economic development, and housing. This material can be viewed alone, or taken alongside other active organizations at the time, such as ABCD, the YWCA, and United Way, which frequently worked with the Urban Coalition to accomplish projects and implement programs. The research for General Revenue Sharing is also featured in the subject files. The collection's third series of reports and research also demonstrate the organization's interests.

The financial files reflect the general day to day work of the Coalition, and the rolodex cards reflect the large network that the organization tapped into.

Arrangement Note:

This collection has been placed into five series. The first represents subject files, arranged alphabetically. The second, finances, includes two subseries: an alphabetical subject file and a chronological group of bank statements. Series III contains reports made by the Urban Coalition and reports passed onto them, along with booklets and publications used for research. Series IV contains the papers of member Helen Wasserman, arranged by subject. Series V are original rolodex cards, kept in original order. A final series, series VI, contains a small number of miscellaneous items not filed with the original subject files.
