Biographical History:

American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees Union was founded in 1932 in Madison, Wisconsin. It would go on to become one of the larger unions representing government employees at various levels.

In the 1960s and 1970s, the police of the City of Bridgeport were represented by AFSCME local 1159, and still are today. Other AFSCME locals that represent City of Bridgeport employees include local 1522.

Neither locals have provided a complete history of their organizations. Research is ongoing.
