Very little information is recorded regarding Freida Mellitz Mendelsohn. She was born on October 23, 1906 in Austria, and died on July 10th, 1989 in Bridgeport. A brief obituary with no biographical information was published in the *Bridgeport Post*. The only additional known information at this time is that her husband was James Mendelsohn.
