Abstract. Benjamin Swan served as the minister for a number of congregations in Fairfield and New Haven counties in the 1830s through the 1890s. While this collection has some material related to his personal life, it primarily contains the genealogical research he conducted for various local families, typically colonial. He was an active member of the Fairfield County Historical Society.

Biographical History:

According to Samuel Orcutt's *History of Stratford and Bridgeport*, "Rev. Benjamin L. Swan was born in Medford, Ma., July 1813; entered College in the Junior Class, but was providentially hindered from completing the course. He received the honorary degree of A.M. from Yale in 1844. He was ordained pastor of the Church in Fair Haven, Conn., in 1836; was installed pastor of the Church in Littlefield, Conn. In 1846. He was acting pastor at the South Church in Bridgeport from June, 1856 to November, 1858. In September, 1858, he accepted the invitation of this Church [Congregational Church of Stratford] and was installed in October, 1858, and dismissed in 1863. In the spring of 1866, he became pastor of the Presbyterian Church in Oyster Bay, NY, where he labored until the Autumn of 1857, when domestic bereavement and ill health obliged him to resign the pastorate."

He was later the pastor of the Monroe Congregational Church from 1880 to 1883 He was an historian and genealogist, and the first to be elected to the Fairfield County Historical Society.

Scope and Content note:

Material has scant records of Swan's own work, and focuses mostly on land records, cemetery inscriptions, and individual family genealogies.

Arrangement Note:

Series I contains Swan's personal material. Series II contains genealogical research, divided into three subseries: general, cemetery inscriptions, and genealogies.
