**Abstract**. Victor Muniec was a highly active force in Bridgeport's civic life. Both Victor and his wife, Judith, were strong proponents of revitalizing the city of Bridgeport, especially through arts and historic preservation. This collection focuses on the various appointments, environmental organizations, arts and history groups, and redevelopment groups that Victor was involved with during the late 1960s into the 1970s, highlighting Bridgeport's history from a citizen's perspective during a time period that is generally seen as Bridgeport's decline due to factory closures and white flight. The collection demonstrates active engagement and work from residents that, when coupled with other similar collections from the 1970s, challenges that narrative.

## **Biographical History:**

Victor E. Muniec was born on July 7, 1924 in Bondsville, Massachusetts. Of Polish heritage, he eventually found his way to Connecticut, where he married his wife, Judith Priestly, in 1958. There presently are no extensive resources about Muniec's time before this, only that he was a radio operator with Company B, 53rd Signal Battalion in World War II.

The couple were incredibly active Bridgeport citizens. Victor held a number of positions at the University of Bridgeport over the years, especially within the Continuing Education division, and was an assistant professor, as well as director of Public Relations. When not there, Muniec sat on a vast swath of boards, committees, and associations, including but not limited to: Mayor William Seres' staff, the Ash Creek Association, chair of the Bridgeport Environmental Protection Commission, and the Bridgeport Architectural Conservancy. An active republican, he worked to ensure a balance in Bridgeport's primarily democratic elections.

Both Victor and Judith were dedicated proponents of revitalizing the city of Bridgeport, especially through arts and historic preservation. A 1974 interview with the *Bridgeport Post* laid out their view that the city had all of the potential to become a cultural center with concert halls and art galleries, and that the development would help lift the city immensely, and they pushed for it through various organizations reflected in the collection. Both were also keen environmental activists, and Judith worked at the Bridgeport Public Library.

The two left Bridgeport as a part of retirement, resettling in the Washington, D.C. area, where Judith died in 2009 and Victor passed away in 2012.

### **Scope and Content note:**

The collection primarily focuses on Bridgeport civic life and projects from the late 1960s into the 1970s, demonstrating the city's complex ecosystem of politics, activism, citizen concerns, and engagement. Muniec's system of filing tends to range towards the broad, so many titles are assigned and reflect this lack of filing. A more product, less process approach was applied to the material due to volume and lack of creator supplied titles for certain series.

Environmental activism is especially pronounced in the collection, with an emphasis on the Long Island Sound and the relationship it has to tidal sanctuaries in the Fairfield County area. This is clear through the presence of various Bridgeport environmental organizations, but especially the Ash Creek Association. The group was one of the earliest environmental groups in the City of Bridgeport, and formed in reaction to bad practice undertaken in the Ash Creek tidal wetlands including illegal filling.

There is also an emphasis on the arts and the arts as a way to develop the city. The never-realized Bridgeport Center for the Arts is the best expression of this relationship. Part of the Congress Plaza development project, the Bridgeport Center for the Arts was an attempt to create a cultural center in the area. There was a particular emphasis on restoring the Majestic and Palace theaters (which as of this writing in 2022 are still in disrepair) in order to enable this. The project was disbanded around 1976 or 1977. Likewise, the "City as a Park" study in the collection, authored by the Bridgeport Conservation Commission through grant funding with the Ford Foundation and the City of Bridgeport, represents research and work done with an environmental emphasis for the sake of development.

Muniec was an active force in republican politics in Bridgeport, a perpetually democratic city. His clippings, as well as his support for William Seres in the 1977 mayoral race, help to shed light on the party's presence in the city and the state.

Also present is material related to the University of Bridgeport, material related to various agencies and organizations Muniec interacted with, and general subject files.

#### **Arrangement note:**

At the time of processing, there was evidence of prior processing to a certain degree. Some material had been placed into Hollinger boxes with specific subject series, while approximately 12 record cartons of material had been labeled as unprocessed. Examination of the unprocessed material revealed a haphazard system of organization, often with similar subject file names scattered throughout, and with a mix of subjects. Upon careful examination and review, it was agreed that processing would be fairly broad, as it is currently not possible to go into all individual folders and remove agendas, minutes, and so on due to the organizational choices made by Muniec at time of record creation. All order and organization is artificial.

Personal agendas make up the first series, reflecting Muniec's activism and involvement in city life.

It is followed by series II, Agencies and organizations, which reflects his commitments and projects.

Arts has been placed next, with two subseries: Bridgeport Center for the Arts and general subject files. The former has minutes, agendas, and plans placed first followed by subject files and then general files. The latter is arranged alphabetically.

Series IV, Education, is arranged into two subseries: HECUS and the University of Bridgeport. HECUS represents only a general grouping of documents. The University of Bridgeport material is arranged alphabetically by subject.

Series V, Environment and Conservation, is the largest and most complicated series in the collection. Containing seven subseries, the first five subseries represent specific organizations. Within these groupings, including the Ash Creek Association and Bridgeport Conservation Commission, all efforts have been made to place any minutes or administrative files first followed by subject files and then general files. Series six, environmental resources and secondary works, represents general reference information and material published related to environmental issues. The subject files are arranged alphabetically.

Series VI, Historic preservation, contains subject files arranged alphabetically and then general files.

Series VII, Planning and Development, is arranged alphabetically by organization.

Series VIII, Politics contains three subseries: the 1977 senate race for Connecticut, the 1977 Bridgeport mayoral race, and subject files. The subject files in particular are primarily clippings – non-clipping based files have been placed first.

Series IX, Subject files, are arranged alphabetically. There is high crossover between the information contained in these files and the rest of the series.

Series X, Photographs, contains photographs, negatives, and slide film arranged alphabetically by subject when possible.
