Biographical History:

Edwin Martin was born in 1943, and was educated at Florida State University, Massachusetts Institute of Technology, and Indiana University. In 1986, he worked as a news photographer for the *Indianapolis News*, as well as various publications such as the *Miami Herald* and Associated Press in 1987. Martin was appointed a professor of philosophy and affiliate professor of journalism at Indiana University from 1968-1989, and has held various appointments at Rutgers University, North Carolina State University, and the University of Maine. He also worked as Curator of Photography at North Carolina State University Visual Arts Center from 1990-1993.

In his career as a photographer, Martin has produced two books, <u>Mud Show: American Tent Circus</u> <u>Life</u> and <u>Hope for a Good Season</u>, as well as an assortment of publications. Martin's work has also been featured in exhibitions at the Albuquerque Museum of Art and the Martha While Gallery, among others. His original photographs are kept in the collections of a variety of prominent institutions, including the Library of Congress, the Ringling Museum of Art in Sarasota, Florida, and the New York Historical Society.

Mud Show: American Tent Circus Life was a project Martin completed in 1988 that paints an intimate picture of American circus life in the late 20th century. "Mud show" is a colloquial term for traveling circuses that do not perform in enclosed venues, but rather outdoors and on dirt, which turns to mud in the rain. Martin had only been doing photography for three years when he began the project, enrolling as a student in the university he taught at in order to get better acquainted with the medium. <u>Mud Show</u> began as a school assignment for the course with Martin finding a subject of interest when the Carson & Barnes Circus arrived in Indiana to perform. Carson & Barnes were one of the six circuses that Martin photographed from 1983 to 1986. He would travel with the circus through six states, sometimes riding with Carson & Barnes over 100 miles to reach their next destination.

In his travels and photographs, Martin was able to create an intimate portrait of modern traveling circuses, showing the lives of performers and circus animals behind the scenes. "The lure of the circus is strong, pulling with the attraction of strange animals and people traveling to exotic places. It is a micro-society of wondrous performers displaying death defying feats," Martin wrote in <u>Mud Show</u>. "But underlying the glitter is a hard life, one filled with eighteen-hour work days, usually seven days each week. It is a life in which children struggle with education in the absence of qualified, systemic supervision. It is a business facing sharp increases in insurance and fuel costs as well as stricter regulation. And it is a legacy of transition... As America changed, so has its tent circuses. Like the rest of the country, they too are trying to prepare for the 21st century." Through his portraits, Martin hoped to show that the American circus is still alive, despite its decline as a source of entertainment, and remains a profound and active link to America's past.

Scope and Content Note:

The Edward Martin Collection of Circus Photographs features a wide array of images from 1983-1988, documenting modern circus life in the 1980s. These photographs contain scenes of animals, performers, and workers behind the scenes, ranging from training sessions to leisure time on the circus grounds, such as resting, religious ceremonies, and interactions between the circus workers. There are 130 images in the collection.

Arrangement note:

The Edwin Martin Collection of Circus Photographs are separated in approximately 9 folders and interleafed with acid free paper. However, the photographs have severely curved over time, meaning that they require more room and do not easily fit into archival folders. The collection included a list provided by the creator, which the History Center has elected to maintain in order to preserve the authenticity of the collection. The photos are arranged by their original titles given by Mr. Martin, names of photography subjects in parenthesis, circus company, location and date.
