Administrative History

Over the years, the Bridgeport History Center has amassed a selection of yearbooks, annual reports, stock holder reports, catalogs, and other like material related to various corporate bodies within Bridgeport. Some were community based, such as Bridgeport Hospital and the Bridgeport Scientific Society, whereas others were related to various Bridgeport based companies like Warner Brothers Company. This artificial collection provides a snapshot of industries and community players through the decades.

Scope and Content Note

Major genre types within the collection include reports such as financial reports for stock holders, yearbooks, and company catalogs. Among the companies represented, Warnaco (formerly Warner Corsets and Warner Brothers Company), Remington Arms, Singer, and General Electric are key players in local industry. Community organizations and local institutions include Bridgeport Hospital, the Bridgeport Fire Department, and the Greater Bridgeport Symphony Orchestra. Years and content vary depending on the individual organization.
