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## Biographical / Historical

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The United Steelworkers union, now the United Steel, Paper and Forestry, Rubber, Manufacturing, Energy, Allied Industrial and Service Workers International Union, was founded in 1942 and grew out of six years of work and conventions from the: Amalgamated Association of Iron, Steel, and Tin Workers and Steel Workers Organizing Committee.

Local 7528 was active in Bridgeport, although their precise history is currently being researched. They were not tied to one company though, as the various agreements they negotiated in this collection make clear. As Bridgeport was still an industrial city, the need for their presence is clear.
