- -- Re-word titles, change colors or other characteristics, change the y-axis values (especially helpful where differences appear exaggerated)


















Income Charts


Please note:







Libraries with more income from other sources (e.g. trusts, donations, etc.) often have lower Municipal Appropriations.
















Expenditure Charts













Many libraries pay for programs through Friends and other groups and do not include those expenditures in their program expenditure numbers.








