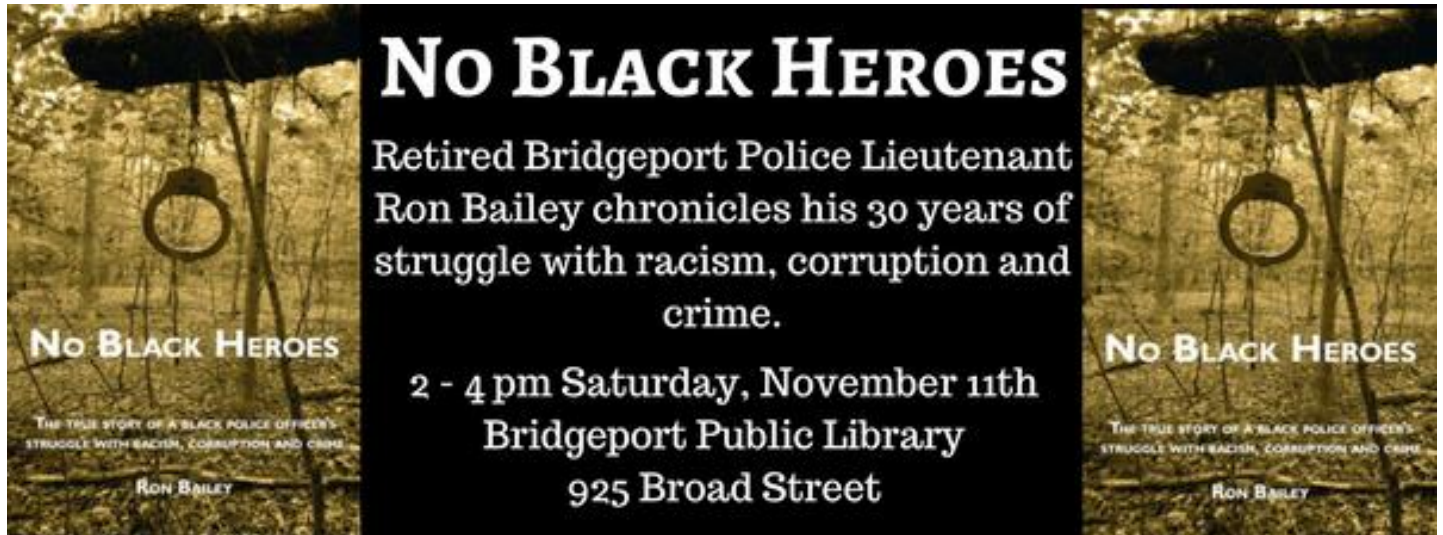


# Meet the Author
