- August was a fun month at Beardsley; we had patrons of all ages spending time in the library and
  cooling off on hot days. Many had continued with the BPL's summer reading program, reading and
  earning prizes and of course attending fun events we've planned. We had almost 4,500 patrons
  visiting us in August and over 1,800 materials circulated that month.
- PROGRAMMING: In August, we offered a great variety of library programs and events such as our
  weekly chess program for kids; weekly story hour, and programs such as Microbit for Kids, where
  participants can learn to control tiny computers to create music, a compass, and much more.
- PROGRAMMING: We held 3 computer classes with total of 41 attendees. The topics were: Canva;
   MS PowerPoint; and MS Word.
- PROGRAMMING: On August 7th, the Discovery Museum conducted a "Be a Space Engineer"
  workshop for students in grades: 2-7. Students could participate in creating a simple rocket models,
  spacesuit designs, and other space engineer related activities.
- Anna has started conversations with Career Resources, Inc. to have their Career Coach parked on Beardsley's parking lot to offer various training workshops, few days in the fall.
- TECHNOLOGY: Brian from Tech. Department was able to give us additional three laptops to be used for our weekly computer classes.
