- June is always an exciting month at the library. Children are eager to begin their summer break, and families take advantage of the many library programs and events we offer, so it's a busy time of the year for all of us.
- **PROGRAMMING:** In June, we held four computer classes with twelve patrons attending. Class topics were: MS Word, Google Chrome Tips & Tricks, Introduction to Canva, and a class on Internet Safety.
- **PROGRAMMING:** As part of our America 250 celebration, we hosted a patriotic wreath making program for adults. The program was well received; with fourteen patrons attending.
- **PROGRAMMING:** On June 27, we've officially launched our Summer Reading Program at the branch by hosting a magic show with Jeff Horton. Attendees were able to register for the program after the performance.
- **COLLECTION:** Throughout June, we featured book displays celebrating America 250, Juneteenth, Father's Day, and the Fifa World Cup. The soccer-themed display proved especially popular with our patrons.
- **In addition to book displays,** the digital display in the lobby, not only promotes the latest arrivals but in June it also featured an America 250 patriotic countdown for the July 4th celebration.
- **TECH:** On June 12, a DNR technician completed updates and sound troubleshooting in both podcast studios. The technician also repaired the BrightAuthor software used for our digital display and also installed the updated software on the Branch Manager's office computer.
- **STAFF RELATED:** Elvis Molina (Library Assistant I) resigned from his position effective June 5. Ana Tollinchi (Library Assistant III) retired effective June 26 after over twenty years of dedicated service.
- Last month, I participated in multiple interviews to fill both Library Assistant positions. We are hopeful that qualified candidates will be selected soon so they can begin training and become valuable members of the Beardsley team.
- Mayor Ganim visited the branch in June to utilize the podcast studios. During his visit, he explored our FIFA Club World Cup book display and gave the library a social media shout-out.
