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## **Highlights**

- June was a fun month at Beardsley. Besides having a good number of visitors stopping by to cool off and borrow books; as at all other branches, we've launched our annual Summer Reading program and have begun encouraging patrons of all ages to sign up and read!
- PROGRAMMING: In June, we held three computer classes with total of 15 attendees. The topics were: Canva; Cloud Storage; and ChatGPT.
- PROGRAMMING: Besides having a MicroBit program, weekly chess classes, story hours, and computer classes, we held a Magic Show with Matt Matthews on June 29<sup>th</sup>. A good number of patrons came for the show.
- PROGRAMMING: Librarians have planned all fun library events for the summer and continue planning for the upcoming fall.
- On June 4<sup>th</sup>, Andre and Phil paid a visit to the Eisenhower Senior Center and taught a computer class to a group of seniors. Two additional sessions were scheduled for July and August.
- Our Digital Navigator Phil has completed nine an hour-long one-on-one session. Most common topics that he taught in June was Excel, Canva, Email and File management.
- Anna and Elvis, along with staff members from other locations, participated in the Black Rock Parade.
- OUTREACH: On Saturday, June 22<sup>nd</sup>, Phil and Elvis participated in Wing Ding Parade at Beardsley ZOO.
- One of our regular daycare visitors, Big Dreams Daycare, brought a group of 3-year old for a storytime and craft on June 3<sup>rd.</sup>
- COLLECTION: Throughout June, we've order hundreds of books and DVDs; with fiscal year ending we made sure to order popular titles and duplicates as well.
- BOOK DISPLAYS IN JUNE: Summer Reading and Juneteenth.
- CONCERNS: We are in need of ordering tables for the building. The tables we presently use belongs to
  other branches and they're not suitable nor comfortable to set up for programs. We hope that all the
  paperwork will go through and our new tables will be ordered soon.
- SUCCESSES: Our podcast studio has been getting more frequent use. In June we counted for 20 recording sessions with total of 37 studio hours spent in the studio by patrons. Besides that, Andre has been teaching Introduction to Podcasting multiple times a month and patrons seem interested in making their own podcasts.
