Highlights

Adult Services

Collections

- Heavy weeding of duplicate materials is well underway in all areas of the library. Good condition materials will be re-allocated to other branches, downtown, etc.
- A large number of new materials arrived in July and was processed. We did receive some duplicate materials and those items were shared out to other branches when appropriate.
- New signage is underway throughout all adult collections and areas to better guide patrons to the
 materials they want/need. Signs include updated genre signs and new Dewey signage, so people know
 what is in each section.

Building and Spaces

- A large amount of furniture has been removed from the building. Some pieces, well past their prime, have been sent to the dump, and others were sent to Burroughs for storage. MANY thanks to David O.'s team for taking care of this!
- Two dehumidifiers have been brought to Black Rock and situated in the basement to combat the moisture that creeps in.
- A large amount of general decluttering and organizing was accomplished in July; much of the branch's unused tech was collected and stored in preparation for a future inventory, and materials (crafting, giveaway books, story time supplies, etc.) have been and continue to be collected and organized.

 No activities this month, but discussions and plans have been started about outreach for the fall and beyond.

Concerns

I have severe concerns about the air quality downstairs. Even with two dehumidifiers (which, on dry days are emptied once a day and on humid ones twice) there are still several significant patches of visible mold. In addition, after significant rainfall, we encounter wet floors in both program room 2 (water leaking under the foundation) and in the staff kitchen area (water leaking down through the walls, possibly as high as the roof). There is also some water damage down through the wall between the children's area and the rear exit hallway.
