Youth Services Update -

This month in Youth Services, we celebrated Women's History Month with themed displays and activities highlighting influential women. We also marked St. Patrick's Day with festive stories and crafts that were well received by our younger patrons.



We had a great turnout for our 3rd grade class visits, with students actively participating and showing enthusiasm for library resources and programs. Our Ramadan Storytime & Craft program was especially popular, welcoming a total of 37 participants and fostering cultural awareness in a fun, engaging way. Teen engagement remained strong this month as well, with many enjoying our movie day and spending time connecting with peers in the library space

Collection Maintenance: Weeding and shifting of the Youth Services collection continued throughout the month.

Adult Services Update –

- **Notary Services:** We facilitated 21 notary appointments this month.
- **Drop-in Tech Help:** This service continues to see steady attendance, averaged at about 2-4 patrons a week. For the Month of March, we had 12 individual tech help sessions.
- **Women who Lead Film Screening:** the movie shown was " Respect", with only 2 attendees.
- **Totes Inspired; Inspirational Tote bag craft:** Was a good turn for this craft with a total of 10 People in attendance
- **Beginner chess:** had a total of 8 attendees for the month
- **The Healing & growth Workshops W/Nellie:** consists of Resource Hour, Conflict resolution, anxiety & depression and Grief & Loss. The workshops with the Social Worker Nellie have seen 7 attendees this month.
- **Energy Assistance W/ Alliance:** We had a decent turn out for it, with 6 people making appointments and at least 2 walk-ins for a total of 8.
