I attended CT Library \& Partners for Digital Equity virtual meeting. Committee members discussed the changes that are scheduled to happen in April and the effects it will have on Conn. residents.

The Technical Services staff continue to weed from our children and adult collections. We are also removing and adding items from our Spanish fiction collection.
